partes he or his assigners. The Residue of my goodes I geve to John my sonne. whome I make my hole exentor  
he to see my dette payde and my will parsonage with the lych and good remysell of my tposse Robert Wyffe  
whome I have put in trusse and have delivred hym myne ffurme afore sufficient record. as shall appere  
herafter to see the true parsonage of this my laste will. and he to have the governour and custodie of John  
my sonne. unto the tyme he come to the yere of dyscrecion. And I make my tposse Robert Wyffe my Overstar  
of this my laste will. witness. I Thomas Clapton Vicar of Blandford. Robert Wyffe. Robert Gardyne p. othes.
