This Will was proved at London before the Worshipful Thomas Bever Doctor of Law Surrogate of the Right Worshipful Edward Simpson also Doctor of Law & Master Keeper or Commissary of the prerogative Court of Canterbury lawfully constituted on the first day of December in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and fifty by the oath of William Witton the sole Executor named in the said Will to whom Administration was granted of all and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of the deceased the having been first sworn duly to Administer &c

I Anne Cullpepper of Clapham in the County of Surrey & Spinster being of Sound disposing Mind Memory and Understanding do make this my last Will and Testament in manner following I bequeath and my soul into the hands of Almighty God my Creator hoping to be saved by and through the merits of Jesus Christ my blessed Saviour and Redeemer And my body I commit to the Earth to be decently buried by my Cousin Elizabeth Davis my Cousin them to her after all my Debts are first paid to every Creditor that my Cousin Elizabeth Davis do pay my funeral Expenses & do thereby constitute her sole Executrix of the residue of what shall be left that is in the house with all my wearing apparel and Linen of all sorts and likewise all Rings and Plate To have and to hold the same unto my Cousin Elizabeth Davis them & do appoint my said Cousin Elizabeth Davis sole Executrix this my Will and do hereby revoke all former Will or Wills by me at any time heretofore made by me whereof of the said Anne Cullpepper the Executrix have her unto set my hand this 4 day of December Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred forty Six Anne Cullpepper
