This Will was proved at London the thirty first
 day of August in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven
 hundred and eighty one before the Worshipful John Fisher
 Doctor of Laws Surrogate of the Right Worshipful Peter
 Calvert Doctor of Laws Master of Requests or Commissary of the
 Prerogative Court of Canterbury lawfully constituted by the
 Oath of James Cluff the sole Executor named in the said
 Will to whom Administration was granted of all and singular
 the Goods Chattels and Credits of the Deceased in having been
 first sworn duly to Administer.

 following Whereas I have in the Stocks the sum of six hundred
 and ninety pounds Stock at three per cent which I bequeath
 as followeth I give to my sister Elizabeth George the sum
 of one hundred pounds Stock I give to my Brother Anthony
 George the sum of one hundred pounds Stock I give to my
 sister Ann Williams the sum of one hundred pounds Stock
 I give the sum of one hundred pounds Stock to my Brother
 William George and his family to be divided amongst them
 as follows ten pounds Stock to my Brother William George
 ten pounds Stock to his wife ten pounds Stock to his daughter
 and the remainder of the said one hundred pounds Stock to
 be equally divided amongst his four sons I give to my sister
 Elizabeth the wife of John Burth one hundred pounds
 Stock for her sole use whose Receipt shall be a sufficient
 discharge to my Executor I give to my sister Ann Davis the
 sum of one hundred pounds Stock this being yet the sum
 of ninety pounds Stock unrequated which I give to Mr
 Benjamin Ellis of Woke Warrat whom I hereby appoint
 to be my sole Executor in trust to discharge my just debts
 funeral Expences and all other Expences which he may be
 put unto concerning this my Will and after such debts and
 Expences are discharged I give the surplus if any remains
 to my before mentioned Nephews to be equally divided

amongst them and my desire is for the said sum of six hundred
and ninety pounds stock to be sold out as soon as convenient
after my decease and divided as before mentioned & hereby revoke
all other Will and Wills by me made in witness whereof I have
income to put my hand and seal this twenty first day of October
in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty
the Mark of ~~Swanah~~ Colpeper ~~Ed~~ signed sealed published
and declared by the said Swanah Colpeper as and for her last
Will and Testament in the presence of us who in her presence
and at her request and in the presence of each other have subscribed

witness whereof to this my said Will I have set my hand and
seal the thirtieth day of June in the Year of our Lord one thousand
