Know ye that I John Whyte for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five hundred pounds of good silver & cash, for w^{ch} I have had good caution for paymt. have bargained alound sold enforced and confirmed & of these things do bargain alound sell enforce and confirm unto Henry Cleeper a Justice of Land of two hundred twenty & five acres more or lesse situate lying and being upon the north side of Little Creek joining upon the land of Tho: Swonger or the said land was in the possession of my father the whyte of Hall and to hold the said land wth all privileges and Jurisdictions whatsoever unto the said Henry Cleeper his heirs or assigns for ever & if the said John Whyte doth land over by heirs executor or administrator in the full value hereof of full gold Cleeper his heirs or assigns shall quietly occupied possessed and enjoy the said land without any lett trouble or hindrance from me the whyte or any one to or from under me, and doe hereby warrant the said the said land unto the said Cleeper his heirs & assigns for ever and shall for ever defend the same in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the 15th day of April 1671
