Shall see him so good was, forbearance to sue And my will and desire is that Edward Simond
and Robert Rose of the Escheat of them shall receive all my rents and profits of my
lands and leases And all money and whatsoever else is or shall be due unto me for and
towards the payment of my debts and legacies and performance of this my last will
and Testament and that my other Executors trouble not themselves therein witness -
according to the trust reposed in them they shall finde especiall occasion for the
same And now if the said S^r Alexander Culpeper havinge heard thid my will
reade unto me do allowe ratifie and publish the same to be my last will and testa-
ment revokinge all my wills testaments or schedules made or dated before this
date herof which is the thirtieth day of January anno domini m^{dc}ccc^{xvii} thousand five
hundred forty four the markes of S^r Alexander Culpeper Sealed subscribed and
published in the presence of Ralph ffrye Chonrad Culpeper Thomas Holt Richard -
Knight

Whereas I S^r Alexander Culpeper of Exceatway Dount in the County of Lancastre have lately
made my last will and Testament in writinge and herte by hand desirous my lands and
tenements leased goods and Chattels to my Executor herein named upon hys and confidens
for the payment of my debts and other charges therin mentioned And whereas I doe by my said
will declare that I woulde haue six pounds in the hundred paid for the interest of my debts
as made by my said last will and Testament apparetlye Now considering with my selfe that if
the profitte of my lands or but one halfe thereof remayninge then six in the hundred as
the lawe now standeth is too little Interest to be paid for my debts But if little or noe
profit can be made or recovered of my lands in respect of the troubles of this tyme or if by
any newe lawe to be made Interest may be reduced to saye lesse a rate than six in the
hundred may come to mony then the profitte of my lands may amount pale or by lawe
ought to be paid for Interest And I doo in this matter to doe that whiche I ought
either in good Conscience or as a faire dealinge man And desirous if it be possible
that noe Troublesome shoulde arise hereafter concerninge the same doe by this my Testam-
ent or explanatione to or upon my said last will and Testament declare my will and
meaninge to be that if my Executors in my said will named accountinge the fyne
from Christmas to Christmas ran in any one year or years before my debts be paid
and noe newe lawe made concerninge the alteration of Interest either halfe scd^m more
or leesse profitte of my lands and leases ad my selfe did in that fyne of pds^m about
all publique chargedes & expences deuised contributions quarterings or billettinges of
soldiers and all other payments and layes laid and putt upon the same cython by
kyng or Parliament or by any newe lawe to be made contrarietie to the same That
then in such year or years off woulde haue Interest paid for my debts after the rate
of eight in the hundred I doo on the other side if by reason of the warres and troubles
of this kyngdom or by reason of kynges exactiones contributions quarterings or
billettinges of soldiers or other charged layes paymed or imposid on land or putt upon
the lands or leases cython by the kyng or Parliament or power of warre halfe set mch^m
profitte easchell be made or recoverd of my lands and leases ad I was woulde to recoverd in
fyne of pds^m or if by any newe lawe default of money shalbe deducted to a lower
rate the now it is That then my will and meaninge is and I doe desire for the
abeydinge of all Troublesome conserninge the same That my Executors in my will
named or the greater number of them shal haue power to make such reasonable
agreement with my Executors concerninge Interest as they or the greater number
of them shal thinke fit or agree to and I doe hereby ratifie and allowe of the same

Secondly But if my Executors or any one of them cannot or will not agree with
 my Executors concerning the same then for the abovesaid office or other Controversies it
 desired that the matter may be determined by Arbitrator or Arbitrators / which are
 proposed to be indifferently chosen between my Executors or the greater number of
 them and such of my Executors or Executrix as shall submit themselves to a Master
 or Wiperage touching the same ratifying and being by approvynge what so ever
 such Arbitrator or Arbitrators / which are proposed shall make or determine a
 concouninge the same according to the submission in that behalf to them made and
 if by none of those means the question concerning the interest of my debts
 be determined then I leave the same to be determined by law and equity according
 to the most honest law and equity of this lande concerninge interest of money
 or otherwise lawed or ruled of equity touching the interest of money as shall
 hereafter be made And I doe herby revoke that parte of my will whiche concerneth
 Interest of my debts And doe make and ordaine this Addicton or declaration
 to be my last will and testament concerninge the Interest of my debts And wheres
 by my said last will I haue debised to me poundes you dined to my executors Dicely
 Dulcoper if shal overlaid her brother my nephew John Dulcoper Esqre & do hereby
 declare that if my Executors remott for any tyme halfe parte of the profitte of
 my estate in manner as aforesaid then I referre it to my Executors to consider whether
 all or any parte of the said summe poundes of Alme shalbe paid unto her or not hereby
 ratifying and confirminge what so ever they shalbe doe concerninge the same
 And I doe further herby will and deesse to me pounds unto Elizabeth Wilson my
 servant towards the furnishinge of a chamber for her self and boord what I haue
 givne her by my said last will and testamant to be paid unto her out of the first
 money that shal come to my Executors hands after my funerall discharged And I gived
 unto her and to my servant Robert Hope to each of them fourty pounds a pece to buy
 them mourninge apparel whiche is all the money that I gived of Alme to her unto
 my said servants Elizabeth Wilson and Robert Hope at my weavinge apparel the
 best suitte therof to Elizabeth Wilson and this rest to be equally debised betwix
 them Item I will and bequeath seauen pounds to Francis Kenward one of my Executors
 in my said will named to be paid him out of the money whiche he hath of mynde in
 his hands if he haue any and if he haue none then out of the first mony of my
 estate whiche shall come to his hands Item I will and bequeath seauen pounds to
 Newlands Dantz & her childe to my dearest wife Item I will and bequeath to the
 said Robert Hope my servant and one of my Executors all his charged prisone duringe
 the tyme of his imprisonment and to helpe paye therof and about his charged
 and to all the rest of my Executors in my will named except the said Robert Hope and
 Francis Kenward & will and bequeath each of them a gold ringe to be bought by my
 Executors of the value of twenty and four shillings a pece for a remembrance of
 me Item I will and bequeath that my Executors shall buy a gold ringe with a
 fifteneigraven upon it of the value of fourty shillings and givne it unto my
 Lengen Elizabeth Ward wife of John Hulcund Esqrs desiringe her to keape it as a remem-
 brance of my love unto her Item I will and bequeath unto Dr Henry Dulcoper knyght
 a gold ringe of the value of forty shillings to be bought by my Executors
 desiringe him to keape it as a remembrance of my love to him Dr Alexander
 Dulcoper his markt Staled signe and published the fourthe of May one thousand
 hundred forty five in the pte of George Robinson Margarett hewet her mark
 Elizabeth Dulcoper her mark

In the name of God Amen witnessas I Amelander Dulcoper
 of Greenway, Dated in the County of Kent knight hand about february or March
 last made my last will and testament in writinge and thereby haue debised my lands
 and tenementes leased goods and chattells to my Executors therin named upon
 trust

trust and confidence for the payment of my debts and legacies and other things
as mentioned above where as I do by my said will declare or mean that I want have
expended in the hundred paid for the interest of my debts as made by my said
will may exceed £1000 consideringe with my self that my debt of £1000
of £1000 £1000 £1000 in suff proportion what interest shall be paid for my
debts but that thereby it may exceed my creditors or less than them if have given
legacies or that out by my said will to have any estate after my debts and legacies are paid
therefore for the avoidance of all Controversies which may arise concerning the interest
of my debts I do by this my will provide that part of my will which concerneth myself
of my debts and leave the consideration of the interest of my debts altogether to
the consideration of the law and equity wherein I have and such other laws or
rules of land and equity as a full Preacher be made concerning the same And
I do also hereby provide for much of one hundred pound or do leave over made
by me to or upon my said will which is sealed signed and published by the power of
my last and now my will which is sealed signed and published by the power of
will and my Codicil of the fourteenth of May last I have given and bequeathed
several legacies unto Elizabeth Wilcock my servant which is a sum not
a sufficient reward for her goods service & the late damage I do therefore as
hereby will and bequeath to the said Elizabeth Wilcock my servant to her
ward 20 shillings for her naturall life over and above what I have
given her by my will and Codicil of the fourteenth of May last by quarterly
payments at the feasts of Midsomer Christmas and our lady
day or within one month after either of the said feasts The first payment
to begin at such of the feasts as shall first happen after my death And because
I hope to have enough of my estate to pay all my debts with a groat
overplus sufficient to performe the rest of my will I do therefore desire
my Executors and legatees that the twenty marks £20 shillings may be duly
paid unto her during her life out of the first profits of my estate
that can be recovered And do in all other matters and things not contrary
to this my codicil ratifie and confirm my said Codicil of the fourteenth of
May last So alleyned & susper his mark. Signed sealed and publish-
