after my decease make publish and declare this my last Will
and Testament in manner following (that is to say) I
first do commend my soul to God that gave it and my
body I commit to the Earth or Sea as it shall please God
to order and as for and concerning all my worldly estate
I give bequeath and dispose thereof as followeth (that is
to say) Item I give unto my beloved friends Thomas the
Coltman and James George both belonging to the
abovesaid ship all such share and summe of money lands
Tenements Goods Chattells and Estate whatsoever as
shall be any ways due to me or owing at this time of
my decease I do give devise and bequeath the same unto
my beloved friends Thomas Coltman and James George
abovesaid I do hereby nominate and appoint the said
Thomas Coltman and James George as my Executors of
this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all
former and other Wills Testaments and Deeds of Gifts
by me heretofore made and I do ordain and ratify
these presents to stand and be for my last Will and
Testament in witness whereof to this my said last Will
I have set my hand and seal the twenty first day of
June One thousand seven hundred and sixteen in the
third year of the reign of Our Sovereign Lord King
George the first England etc. Francis Culpepper. Signed Sealed
