dwelling house or nere the stock market in the parish of Saint Ma
ry Woolthorpe London in the City of London And all other my meynage
saids ornaments and appurtenances whatsoever and wheresoever in
the Kingdom of England Do have and to hold unto her the said Mary his
heire and assigns forever Item I give and bequeath unto my loving
friend Mr John Purfield of Baitell the somme of ten pounds to be paid by
my executors within twelve months next after my decease All the rest and
residue of my goods chattells plate Jewells personalls household stuffe and
personall estate I give and bequeath unto my said dear and loving
wife Mary whom I make and ordayne sole executrix of this my last
will and Testament In witness wherof I have sett my hand & seale

 hereto in trust for my said brother, And give the said Thomas Wright
 five pounds ^{for his pains} And I doe declare that presents only to be and to be my
